#### **Synopsis:**

The seminar provides the essential knowledge and skills to handle life threatening emergencies in an office setting. Indications for emergency drug use and proper dosages are clearly detailed. We will discuss how best to assemble and maintain an ideal drug kit. We will provide background and practical know-how for critical tests that will reduce overall risks. This seminar will review and provide each participant with color coded instructional cards depicting the most common life threatening situations with algorithms providing an easy, step-by-step action plan for both dentist and staff. The latest routes of administration for each of the "Top 10" Essential Drugs will be demonstrated. There are no IV drugs included. We will also review the legal and moral obligations that are presented by a medical emergency. This is presented as an interactive (voluntary basis) learning experience. After graduating from New York University College of Dentistry in 1978, Dr. Daniel G. Pompa completed a General Practice Residency at Long Island Jewish Hospital, followed by specialty training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Lincoln Hospital, New York Medical College. In 1982, he became a Fellow of The American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons and in 1992 a Fellow in The International Congress of Oral Implantologists. Dan is now a visiting speaker at eight Dental Schools throughout the U.S.

Dr. Pompa is now an author with eight courses on-line and has published in many journals such as: The Journal of the American Dental Association, Dentistry Today and the New York State Journal of the Academy of General Dentistry. He has been featured as a Seminar Series Speaker/Consultant for the American Dental Association. Dr. Pompa is now a Colgate Speaker and has a course "Medical Emergencies in the Dental Practice" on the Colgate Website. Dentistry Today has cited Dr. Pompa as a "Leader in Continuing Education in 2018, 2019 and 2020". He has presented over 600 lectures both Nationally and Internationally.
